





2. Valley fold the sides to the center.




3. Valley fold the edges outwards.




4. Turn over.




5. Valley fold towards the imaginary edge, leaving a small gap from the corner.




6. Squash fold the other side down to match.




7. Mountain fold the hidden corner inside.




8. Rabbit ear the flap over.




9. Swing the rear flap to the other side.







10. Open out the top layer.





11. Valley fold to the center.



12. Pleat the flap, noting the dotted intersection.









14. Valley fold in half, tucking the flap into the pocket.

15. Reverse fold, leaving a small gap at the middle.




17. Precrease lightly.


16. Open out the flap.




18. Valley fold to the last crease.




19. Valley fold the sides, leaving a small gap at the center.
